Horses being removed from sale area must have hip # still visible and paid purchase receipt from sale office.

ALL BUYERS must obtain a bidder's number prior to bidding. A current drivers license with photo and a second form of ID must be presented at the time of registration for a bidder's number.

All accounts must be paid during or immediately following the end of the sale. Deadline for settlement for the Greener Pastures Ranch and Windy Ridge Farm Paso Fino Sale is within one hour from the close of the sale.

All sales or transactions of horses made on the sale grounds must be reported to and made through the sale office.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE

The purpose of these terms and conditions is to set forth the obligations of the consignor and the purchaser. All transactions are governed by these “Terms & Conditions”. All buyers must obtain a bidders number prior to bidding. All persons receiving a bidders number will sign a statement of their acceptance and agreement to the following conditions.

1. **Applicable Law:** All horses in this sale are offered according to the laws of the state where in the sale is conducted. The right to bid, as provided under law, is reserved for all consignors unless otherwise announced. No horses in this sale are offered at absolute auction, consignors have the right to bid or have their representative bid for them to retain ownership of horses not receiving a satisfactory offer. A member of the sale staff may be designated by the consignor as their representative to protect their horses up to a specified amount. Alan Parker Auctioneer reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
2. There is no warranty expressed or implied by the auctioneer, sponsors, owner or consignor, as to the performing soundness, merchantability of fitness for any particular purpose of any horse offered in this sale. All horses are sold “as is” with all existing conditions and defects, if any.
3. Terms of sale are payment in full must be made within one hour of the completion of sale. Settlement may be made in the form of US Currency, Certified Check, Travelers Check, Personal Check (accompanied by a Bank Letter of Good Standing & Credit), Visa, MasterCard or American Express. Checks must be made out to “Alan Parker Auctions”. In no case may the purchaser pay any part of the purchase price directly to the consignor. All checks must be drawn on a U.S Bank or an International Money Order, cash must be American Currency. Buyer agrees not to stop on check for any reason.
4. **Bidding Procedure:** The person making the highest bid recognized by the Auctioneer shall be the buyer. Should there be any contention where two or more bidders are claiming the same bid the auctioneer’s decision as to whom he recognized at a certain figure is final. If the buyer fails to show himself to the auctioneer and present his buyer’s number, or fails to comply with these conditions of sale, Auctioneer reserves the option to resell the horse.
5. Buyers assume all expenses and risks on horses after horses have been struck down to them. Upon receiving payment for the horse, the cashier will issue a paid receipt to obtain delivery. Buyer must present this order to stable manager at the time the horse is removed from the grounds.

6. All registration papers will be withheld by the sale management until all checks clear the bank, at which time they will be mailed to the buyer by **certified mail**. If any buyer desires to obtain papers immediately, the horse or horses must be paid for in full with cash or cashier's check.
7. If any person shall purchase a horse and not pay for it as described above, the sale management or consignor shall have the option to resell the horse or at their option bring legal action in which event buyer agrees to pay all cost of such suit together with reasonable attorney fees as fixed by the court. In the event of resale the defaulting buyer agrees to pay all costs of resale and price deficiency, if any.

Each broodmare selling as bred to a stallion will have been examined by a veterinarian within ten (10) days of the Sale and reported at the sale as "in foal", "open", "barren" or "bred" (meaning an insufficient amount of time has passed to determine pregnancy). Any and all mares with or without representation by the consignor as to their pregnancy status are subject to a palpation exam at the **Buyer's Request and Expense** on the mare's exit from the sale ring and within 12 hours from the fall of the hammer and **PRIOR TO REMOVAL FROM SALE PREMISES** by a veterinarian acceptable to sale management.

11. Consignor has the responsibility to notify the sales management in writing prior to the sale of any unsoundness of any nature known to him and such unsoundness, if any, will be announced at the time of sale. Buyers may request a veterinary examination prior to the start of the sale with the consignor's approval. Except for the limited warranties contained in these terms and conditions, each animal is sold "as is" with all defects and existing conditions, and without warranty of any kind, express or implied. **THE BUYER HAS THE RESPONSIBILITY TO EXAMINE HORSES BEFORE BIDDING.**
12. The consignor has the responsibility to notify the sales management in writing prior to the sale of any exceptions to the following: (1) the horse is free of functional deficiencies with respect to eyes (2) the horse is not a cribber (3) the horse has not been nerved (4) the sex or condition of a gelding or ridgeling is as described in the catalog (5) a colt or stallion at least 18 months of age does possess at time of sale two testes descended to the scrotum (6) any mare or filly must possess two palpable ovaries, and (7) title to the horse is free from all adverse claims of ownership, use or possession. In the event a horse possesses any of these defects it shall be the consignor's sole responsibility to inform the office of Alan Parker Auctions or the Sale Announcer of such defects in a timely manner so that the proper announcements can be made while the horse is in the auction ring. A recorded tape will be made of the entire sale, which will be used to determine what announcements were made. Reveille de Roul Sin Paris, in his very self, an anomaly to our production program. Greener Pastures has so many breeding stallions that we rarely search outside our barn for the right knick for a mare. We had a number of wonderful mates for Capuchino's Champana but could not pass up a National Champion Performance Stallion like Roul. It was not his impressive credits, but the Cancionero and Contrallano sewn into his lineage that made us swoon. We fantasized about that new dynamic in our bloodlines and you can see, we were right on. Reveille is high-headed like his dad and he carries himself with majesty. Like Roul, he is securely gaited. If he were a filly, you would have to mortgage your house to own him because this guy is a solid herd-sire prospect. We'll give this cross a second chance in 2010 and pray harder for a girl.

Sire: Roul was, I think, a virgin when he matriculated to Greener Pastures stud row in 2007. He had belonged to Debbie and Carl Gray and no foals have been recorded. His current owner, Amanda Hamilton, was afraid his inexperience would put him in jeopardy in a live cover so the poor guy was limited to breeding the "dummy" for his first few "lucky" dates. His gentle manner belied his talents as we soon found. Roul was a natural lover, wooing and winning mares with the best of them. Even the witchiest of our girls succumbed to his amour and his nimbleness was unnecessary because the heels never flew.

You have seen him ridden now and you see the quality of his gait, his animation, his quickness and his show style. You haven't seen him in the breeding pen. Roul is a true gentleman and a scholar.

Dam: Champana Sin Par is a lovely, cream-buckskin Capuchino daughter and a Lunares granddaughter. There are a lot of Capuchino offspring about, but Lunares is hard to find on paper today. He was an extremely talented, stunning, big, white import from Colombia that was very much respected in the sixties and seventies. He was lost in an estate settlement, was abducted at gunpoint, was horse-napped and hidden for weeks, was under-shown, underbred and sometimes underfed and was eventually bought by paragons in our breed, the Bud Magnuses. I'll have to tell you the story sometime. I like to think the blood of Lunares adds to the drama of Champana. Champana is half sibling to the much-coveted Planeta - a fino filly and our highest seller of all time.

Creacion's 3 Year Old Performance filly, **Juanita de Creacion** was the 2009 National Champion Performance Schooling filly.

Jurado, in 2009, was the Reserve National Champion Performance Schooling A/0 Colts. Fourth National Champion Pleasure Schooling Colts, Third National Champion Pleasure Schooling A/0 Colts.

Jurado was a winner right out of the gate. He has a lot of presence with very crisp and even action. He is easy for the amateur to ride and easily transitions to the professional classes. He has a fun and engaging personality. Hauls easily and handles shows well. His first foal is expected on the ground in 2010. Because of his bloodlines, he should stand up well in the breeding pen.
